RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF MABEL PETERS.

1 *Resolved*, That for the purpose of discharging a
2 moral obligation of the commonwealth, there be
3 allowed and paid out of the state treasury, subject
4 to appropriation, to Mabel Peters, wife of Joseph S.
5 Peters, such sums as may be appropriated therefor,
6 to compensate her for the death of her husband, the
7 said Joseph S. Peters, a former employee of the Worces-
8 ter county sheriff's office who died in nineteen hundred
9 and fifty-two of injuries sustained in a jail fire in the
10 year nineteen hundred and thirty-nine.
