By Mr. Costello of Boston, petition of John W. Costello that civil service employees of the Metropolitan Transit Authority be entitled to pay for holidays and vacation and sick leave rights possessed by them at the time of their transfer from the Boston transit department. Metropolitan Affairs.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE EMPLOYEES OF THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY WHO ARE UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE LAWS SHALL BE ENTITLED TO THE SAME PAID HOLIDAYS, VACATION AND SICK LEAVE RIGHTS POSSESSED BY THEM UPON THEIR TRANSFER FROM THE BOSTON TRANSIT DEPARTMENT TO THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The employees of the Metropolitan Transit Author-
2 ity, to whom the civil service laws and rules apply as
3 provided by paragraph (d) of section three, of chapter
4 five hundred and seventy-two of the acts of nineteen
5 hundred and forty-nine, shall retain the annual paid
6 holidays, annual vacation and annual sick leave that
7 appertained to them at the time of the transfer.
