The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Three.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EMPLOYMENT BY THE TOWN OF NATICK OF NILS SWENSON AS A LIBRARY CUSTODIAN AND RELATIVE TO HIS RETIREMENT RIGHTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law
2 to the contrary, the town of Natick is hereby author-
3 ized to continue the employment of Nils Swenson as
4 custodian of the library of said town known as Morse
5 Institute after attaining the maximum age for his
6 group under the contributory retirement system of
7 said town, and when retired under said system he
8 shall receive the superannuation retirement allowance
9 to which he is entitled at the time of his retirement
10 thereunder; provided, however, that such employ-
11 ment shall not extend beyond June first, nineteen
12 hundred and fifty-four. During the period of his ex-
13 tended employment deductions shall be made from
14 his regular compensation and paid into the annuity
15 savings fund of said system.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
