RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF GORDON R. COTE OF FITCHBURG.

1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of discharging a
2 moral obligation of the commonwealth, and subject to
3 appropriation, there shall be allowed and paid out of
4 the state treasury to Gordon R. Cote, of Fitchburg,
5 the sum of one thousand dollars to compensate him
6 for the loss by severance of a part of a finger sustained
7 by him while attending a practical art class at the
8 state teachers college at Fitchburg.
