AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A FIVE DAY WEEK FOR MEMBERS
OF THE POLICE FORCE OF THE TOWN OF WEBSTER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of general or special
2 law to the contrary, there shall be printed upon the
3 official ballot to be used by the town of Webster at
4 the next annual town election the following question:
5 — “Shall the town of Webster accept the provisions
6 of section 16C of chapter 147 of the General Laws
7 providing for a five day week for members of the
8 police forces in cities and towns?” If a majority of
9 the votes in answer to said question is in the affirma-
10 tive, this section shall take full effect in the said town
11 of Webster, but not otherwise.
