RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY THE ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE OF DISTRICT COURTS RELATIVE TO REQUIRING JUDGES TO WEAR THE ROBES OF THEIR OFFICIAL OFFICE WHILE HOLDING COURT.

1 *Resolved*, That the administrative committee of dis-  
2 trict courts be requested to investigate the subject  
3 matter of current house document numbered ten hun-  
4 dred and two, relative to requiring judges to wear the  
5 robes of their official office while holding court, and to  
6 report to the general court its conclusions and recom-  
7 mendations in relation thereto by filing the same with  
8 the clerk of the house of representatives on or before  
9 the first Wednesday of December in the current year.
