AN ACT ENABLING THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX TO MAKE IMPROVEMENTS TO THE SUPERIOR COURT BUILDING IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of providing adequate
2 accommodations in the superior court building at
3 Cambridge, in the county of Middlesex, the county
4 commissioners of said county may alter or remodel
5 and make additions to said building, and furnish and
6 equip said additions and alterations, and do all things
7 incidental thereto.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes of this act, the
2 county treasurer of said county, with the approval of
3 the county commissioners, may borrow from time to
4 time, on the credit of the county, such sums as may
5 be necessary, not exceeding in the aggregate
6 dollars, and may issue temporary notes of the county
