AN ACT RELATIVE TO APPROPRIATIONS BY THE TOWN OF  
PROVINCETOWN FOR MUNICIPAL ADVERTISING PUR-  
POSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Provincetown may an-  
2 nually appropriate a sum of money not to exceed  
3 three thousand dollars for advertising the advan-  
4 tages of the town with special reference to its facili-  
5 ties for summer vacation, recreation, seashore and  
6 residential purposes. The money so appropriated  
7 shall be expended under the direction of the select-  
8 men.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its  
2 acceptance by said town within five years after its  
3 passage.
