AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE PRESENT CLERK
OF THE THIRD DISTRICT COURT OF PLYMOUTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of
2 section seventy-nine of chapter two hundred and
3 eighteen of the General Laws, the salary of the present
4 incumbent of the office of clerk of the third district
5 court of Plymouth shall be thirty-eight hundred
6 dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
