By Mr. Brown of Fairhaven, petition of Albert E. Stanton and others (selectmen, for legislation relative to the proposed new sewerage system in the town of Fairhaven. Public Health.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PROPOSED NEW SEWERAGE SYSTEM IN THE TOWN OF FAIRHAVEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The present sewerage committee of the town of
2 Fairhaven shall constitute the Authority to engage
3 engineers, purchase engineering plans and specifica-
4 tions, and to control and dispense any and all sums
5 which the town may, from time to time, appropriate
6 for the construction of the proposed new sewerage
7 system, and to act with full authority for the town in
8 all matters involving such construction until such
9 time as the system is completed with approval by
10 them, at which time the authority and responsibility
11 for the system shall be relinquished to the Fairhaven
12 Board of Sewer and Water Commissioners. In the
13 event of the inability of any member of said present
14 committee to serve, he shall be replaced by the original
15 appointing party for that member. The appointing

16 parties of one member each being as follows:— board
17 of sewer and water commissioners; board of select-
18 men; chairman, precinct 1; chairman, precinct 2;
19 chairman, precinct 3; chairman, precinct 4; chair-
20 man, precinct 5; finance committee; and Fairhaven
21 Association of Businessmen.
