RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE INVESTIGATION  
AND STUDY BY THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ON TAXATION.

1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission,  
2 known as the special commission on taxation, estab-  
3 lished by chapter eighty-six of the resolves of nineteen  
4 hundred and forty-eight and most recently continued  
5 by chapter one hundred and three of the resolves of  
6 nineteen hundred and fifty-two, shall, in making its  
7 investigation and study, consider the subject matter  
8 of the investigation and study proposed by current  
9 senate document numbered five hundred and fifty-  
10 one, relative to the advisability of changing the fiscal  
11 year of municipalities from the calendar year to the  
12 fiscal year of the commonwealth.
