AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS OR
THE CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN WAYS IN THE CITY OF
BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 10 of chapter 393 of the acts
2 of 1906, as amended by section 1 of chapter 117 of
3 the acts of 1947, is hereby further amended by insert-
4 ing after the second sentence the following sentence:
5 — No construction permit shall be issued by said
6 board unless the issuance thereof shall have been ap-
7 proved by the city planning board of said city.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July first
2 in the current year.
