*Ordered,* That the committee on Conservation is hereby authorized, in making its study and investigation, under the provisions of Senate Order No. 654 (adopted by the House, with amendments, on May 4, 1953, and concurred in by the Senate, with amendments in the Senate on May 21, 1953) to investigate and study the feasibility of leasing, purchasing or acquiring by eminent domain the land adjacent to Miller's River in the towns of Athol and Royalston. Said committee, during its investigation and study, shall have the assistance of such agencies, departments, boards, commissions and officers of the state government as may be requested by said committee to assist and co-operate.
