AN ACT TO FIX THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR AND OWNERSHIP OF MILK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 12, Chapter 94A is hereby amended by
- 2 adding the following section:
- 3 *Section 12B.* Bulk Tank milk dealers and their agents
- 4 shall take responsibility for and ownership of all milk taken
- 5 from the producers tank.

The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall have the right to elect and remove the members of the Board of Directors and to fill any vacancies which may occur.

The Corporation shall be known as the Corporation.
