AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPORTIONMENT OF THE COSTS OF COUNTY GOVERNMENT BETWEEN THE CITIES OF BOSTON, CHELSEA AND REVERE AND THE TOWN OF WINTHROP.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary the
2 expenses of county government in the county of Suffolk, in-
3 cluding the operation of county installations and the furnishing
4 of county services such as the house of correction, the county
5 jail, registry of deeds, the courts and medical examiners, shall
6 be apportioned among the cities of Boston, Chelsea and Revere
7 and the town of Winthrop in proportion to the populations of
8 said cities and town according to the nineteen hundred and
9 fifty census returns.
