AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY KNOWN AS THE SOUTHEAST EXPRESSWAY AS PILGRIMS HIGHWAY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 That portion of the state highway known as the Southeast  
2 Expressway which lies between the Quincy-Milton line and the  
3 Plymouth-Bourne line, except any bridge or overpass thereon  
4 which has been named or designated under the provisions of  
5 any prior act, shall, upon its completion, be designated and  
6 known as Pilgrims Highway. Suitable markers bearing said  
7 designation shall be erected at appropriate places thereon by  
8 the department of public works. Said department may expend  
9 for the purposes of this act such sums as may be appropriated.
