**AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING LODGING HOUSES.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 22 of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as appear-  
2 ing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by insert-  
3 ing after the word "institutions", in line 5, the words: — nor  
4 convalescent or nursing homes or rest homes licensed under  
5 section seventy-one of chapter one hundred and eleven.
