
By Mr. Wall, petition of William X. Wall for legislation to make permanent certain temporary positions in the State Department of Public Works in district five. Public Service.

AN ACT MAKING PERMANENT CERTAIN TEMPORARY POSITIONS IN THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS IN DISTRICT FIVE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of general law
2 to the contrary, or any provision of the general appropriation
3 act of nineteen hundred and fifty-nine or of any provision of
4 any supplementary appropriation act for the year nineteen
5 hundred and fifty-nine, the number of permanent positions
6 duly approved in each item of appropriation for personal serv-
7 ices shall be increased to include every temporary position as
8 a number four man in the department of public works in dis-
9 trict five for which for a continuous period of three years or
10 more past from January first, nineteen hundred and fifty-five,
11 compensation has been duly paid or authorized under the same
12 or a like item in connection with the maintenance of the de-
13 partment of public works. The director of personnel shall, by
14 title and subject to the approval of the commission on admin-
15 istration and finance, certify to the budget commissioner, the
16 comptroller, the director of civil service, the commissioner of
17 public works and the senate and house committees on ways
18 and means, each such position to be included.
