
By Mr. Fleming, petition of William D. Fleming for legislation to establish a maximum rate of excise tax on registered motor vehicles and trailers. Taxation.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM RATE OF EXCISE TAX ON REGISTERED MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAILERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first sentence of section 1 of chapter 60A of the Gen-
2 eral Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 640 of the acts
3 of 1954, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "sixty-
4 three", in line 8, the words: — except that no rate hereunder
5 shall be in excess of sixty-six dollars and ninety-six cents per
6 thousand, — so as to read as follows: — Except as hereinafter
7 provided, there shall be assessed and levied in each calendar
8 year on every motor vehicle and trailer registered under chap-
9 ter ninety, for the privilege of such registration, an excise
10 measured by the value thereof, as hereinafter defined and de-
11 termined, at the average state rate for the calendar year, as
12 determined in the manner provided in section fifty-eight of
13 chapter sixty-three, except that no rate hereunder shall be in
14 excess of sixty-six dollars and ninety-six cents per thousand.
