The committee on Ways and Means, to whom was committed the House Bill authorizing the Department of Public Works to transfer to the control of the metropolitan district commission such state highways or portions thereof as are no longer needed for state highway purposes, subject to limited access conditions, where established (House, No. 60), report recommending that the same ought to pass, with an amendment substituting a "Resolve increasing the scope of the special commission established to make a study relative to the organization and operation of the Metropolitan District Commission and other matters" (Senate, No. 585).

RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE A STUDY RELATIVE TO THE ORGANIZATION AND OPERATION OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION AND OTHER MATTERS.

1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission established by
2 chapter one hundred and forty of the resolves of nineteen hun-
3 dred and fifty-eight, and most recently continued by chapter
4 one hundred and eleven of the resolves of nineteen hundred
5 and fifty-nine, shall, in the course of its investigation and
6 study consider the subject matter of current house document
7 numbered 60, relative to authorizing the department of public
8 works to transfer to the control of the metropolitan district
9 commission such state highways or portions thereof as are no
10 longer needed for state highway purposes, subject to limited
11 access conditions, where established.
