The Committee on Bills in the Third Reading to which was referred the House bill authorizing the city of Lynn to improve, lay out or sell any part or parts or the whole of the unused portion of certain park land on Magnolia avenue, so called, in said city (House, No. 3140) reports recommending that the same be amended by substituting therefor a new draft entitled "An act authorizing the city of Lynn to sell certain park land on Magnolia avenue, so called, in said city" (Senate, No. 620) and that, when so amended, the same will be correctly drawn.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LYNN TO SELL CERTAIN PARK LAND ON MAGNOLIA AVENUE, SO CALLED, IN SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Lynn may, subject to the approval
2 of the board of park commissioners of said city, sell the whole
3 or any part of the unused portion of certain park land on
4 Magnolia avenue, so called, in said city, bounded and de-
5 scribed as follows: — Northeasterly by land of the City of
6 Lynn, two hundred seven and sixty one-hundredths feet;
7 Westerly by land of Helman twenty-six and forty-nine one-
8 hundredths feet; Southwesterly by land of Helman, Keith
9 and Suttie, one hundred seventy-eight and thirty-six one-
10 hundredths feet; Southeasterly by land of Lynn Housing
11 Authority thirteen and eighty-seven one-hundredths feet; con-
12 taining thirty-seven hundred thirty-seven square feet, more
13 or less, and shown as lot numbered six on plan entitled "Lynn
14 Off-Street Parking Commission, Curtis Square, Lynn", dated
15 January, nineteen hundred and sixty, and signed by William
16 B. Hilton, City Engineer.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance
2 during the current year by the city council of said city, sub-
3 ject to the provisions of its charter, but not otherwise.
