RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS RELATIVE TO THE CONVEYANCE BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF A CERTAIN PORTION OF THE PROVINCE LANDS IN THE TOWN OF PROVINCETOWN TO SAID TOWN.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public works, through
2 its division of waterways, is hereby authorized and directed
3 to make an investigation and study of the subject matter of
4 current house document numbered 3290 providing for the
5 conveyance to the town of Provincetown of certain lands by
6 the commonwealth. Said department shall report to the
7 general court the results of its investigation and study, and
8 its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legisla-
9 tion necessary to carry such recommendations into effect,
10 by filing the same with the clerk of the senate on or before
11 the last Wednesday in December in the current year.
