By Mr. Wall, petition of William X. Wall for legislation to require that certain motor vehicles be equipped with suitable guards for rear wheels. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REQUIREMENT THAT CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES BE EQUIPPED WITH SUITABLE GUARDS FOR THE REAR WHEELS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 7 of chapter 90 of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence,
3 added by section 1 of chapter 570 of the acts of 1954, and in-
4 serting in place thereof the following sentence: — Every motor
5 vehicle or trailer, excepting passenger motor vehicles, operated
6 in or upon any way shall be equipped with suitable guards
7 which will effectively reduce the spray to the rear of mud,
8 water or slush caused by the rear wheels thereof.
