In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-One.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A FAIR, ADEQUATE AND SIMPLIFIED STATE
INCOME TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The General Laws are hereby amended by inserting after
2 chapter 62B the following chapter: —

3 CHAPTER 62C.

4 *Section 1.* Notwithstanding any other provisions in the
5 General Laws, especially in chapter sixty-two, on or before
6 April fifteenth of each year, every resident or inhabitant of
7 the commonwealth shall pay as his state personal income tax
8 for income received the previous calendar year seven per cent
9 of the amount of the tax imposed or levied under the federal
10 internal revenue code on such income for the previous calendar
11 year. This shall replace the tax on all personal income of in-
12 dividuals in chapter sixty-two.
