AN ACT PERMITTING THE SELECTMEN OF THE TOWN OF MARBLEHEAD TO DIVIDE PRECINCT FOUR IN THE TOWN OF MARBLEHEAD FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF FACILITATING VOTING THEREIN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the
2 territory presently comprising precinct four in the town of
3 Marblehead may be divided for the sole purpose of facilitating
4 voting therein. Every such division of said precinct shall be
5 designated by the addition of a letter to the number designating
6 said precinct. Notice of each division shall be given
7 forthwith to the state secretary. Except as provided herein,
8 all provisions of law relating to voting precincts and polling
9 places shall apply to such divisions. Within twenty days after
10 such a division, the selectmen shall cause notice in writing to
11 be given to each registered voter in said precinct so divided
12 specifying the polling place to be used by such voter. A division
13 of said precinct made hereunder shall take effect on the thirty-
14 first day of December following the making thereof.
