In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-One.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF CERTAIN FOOD CONSISTING OF VEGETABLE PRODUCTS AND USED AS A LIGHT CREAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 194 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting after section 190 the following section: — *Section*
3 *190A.* Notwithstanding any contrary provision of section one
4 hundred and eighty-seven, any article of food which is a vege-
5 table product, and not a dairy product, and is used as a light
6 cream shall not be deemed to be misbranded; provided it con-
7 tains the following ingredients only: water, vegetable fat, corn
8 syrup solids, stabilizing agent and artificial coloring, nor shall
9 such article be deemed to be adulterated, within the meaning
10 of this chapter, nor shall the distribution and sale of such
11 article be prohibited.
