RESOLVE REVIVING AND CONTINUING THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE SYSTEMS OF SEWERAGE AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL IN THE NORTH AND SOUTH METROPOLITAN SEWAGE DISTRICTS AND THE CITY OF BOSTON, AND THE WATER SYSTEMS IN SAID DISTRICTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY OF THE METROPOLITAN WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM.

1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission established
2 by chapter one hundred and twenty-nine of the resolves of nine-
3 teen hundred and fifty-six, and most recently revived and con-
4 tinued by chapter sixty-three the resolves of nineteen hundred
5 and fifty-nine is hereby further revived and continued for the
6 purpose of continuing its investigation and study relative to
7 the metropolitan water supply system and the metropolitan
8 water district.

9 Said commission shall be furnished by the metropolitan dis-
10 trict commission with such technical and other assistance as
11 it may require, and shall have the right to call upon other
12 state departments, boards or commissions for such informa-
13 tion and assistance as it may deem necessary for its purpose.
14 Said commission shall be provided with quarters in the state
15 house or elsewhere, may travel within and without the com-
16 monwealth, may employ such engineering and other assistants
17 and incur such expenses as may be necessary to carry out the
18 purposes of this resolve, and for said purposes may expend
19 the balance available in item 0257-14 as made available by
20 chapter three hundred and eighteen of the acts of nineteen
21 hundred and sixty and such additional sums as may be ap-
22 propriated. The expenditure of the balance of said item 0257-14
23 and of such additional sums appropriated for the purposes of
24 this resolve shall be assessed on the metropolitan water dis-
25 trict.

26 Said commission may report from time to time to the
27 general court the results of its investigation and study here-
28 under, and its recommendations, together with drafts of
29 legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect,
30 by filing the same with the clerk of the senate, but in any
31 event shall file its final report with said clerk on or before
32 the last Tuesday in December, nineteen hundred and sixty-two.
