## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Three.

AN ACT DIRECTING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIDDLESEX COUNTY TO PAY CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE REGISTRY OF DEEDS, SOUTH DISTRICT, CERTAIN SUMS OF MONEY FOR OVERTIME SERVICE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The county commissioners of Middlesex county are hereby  
2 authorized and directed to pay to the following employees of  
3 the Middlesex South District Registry of Deeds, for overtime  
4 services rendered in the construction of the grantor and  
5 grantee indexes of said registry the sums set forth after their  
6 respective names: — Paul Jones, sixty-two dollars and five  
7 cents; John Heback, fifty-three dollars and thirty-nine cents;  
8 Francis Walker, forty-five dollars and thirty-three cents;  
9 Allen Stirling, forty-two dollars and sixty-four cents; Robert  
10 Smith, thirty-nine dollars and ninety-five cents; John Mc-  
11 Carthy, thirty-three dollars and sixty-seven cents; Mary Ser-  
12 son, thirty-three dollars and sixty-seven cents; James Hour-  
13 han, thirty dollars and fifty-eight cents; Paul Shwab, twenty-  
14 three dollars and thirty-six cents; and John Curran, twelve  
15 dollars and five cents. Said amounts shall be expended from  
16 available funds in the county treasury.
