The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Three.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE SALARY OF THE PRESIDENT OF A STATE COLLEGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 73 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
- 2 serting after section 3 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 3A.* The president of each state college and the
- 4 president of the Massachusetts college of art shall receive a
- 5 salary of not less than seventeen thousand dollars nor more
- 6 than twenty thousand dollars, the amount to be determined
- 7 by the board of education.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE STATE UNIVERSITY.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Session assembled, and by the authority of the State at large.

- 1 Chapter 11 of the General Laws is hereby amended by the
- 2 addition of section 7 in the following manner:
- 3 Section 7. The president of each state college and the
- 4 president of the State University shall create a
- 5 board of trustees, to be known as the Board of Trustees of
- 6 that State University, and the members thereof shall be
- 7 appointed by the Board of Regents.
