AN ACT REGULATING OPERATION OF TRUCKS CARRYING SAND OR GRAVEL SO AS TO PREVENT THE DROPPING OF SUCH SAND OR GRAVEL ON THE WAYS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 36 of chapter 85 of the General Laws, inserted by  
2 chapter 303 of the acts of 1951 and most recently amended by  
3 chapter 160 of the acts of 1962 is hereby amended by adding  
4 at the end the following paragraph: — A vehicle loaded with  
5 unbaled hay, sand or gravel or rubbish or refuse shall not be  
6 driven or moved on any such way unless the load of sand or  
7 gravel is covered with a tarpaulin, or any suitable coverage,  
8 to prevent the hay, sand or gravel blowing or falling on the  
9 highway.
