AN ACT CHANGING THE JOB GROUP CLASSIFICATION FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE NEW BEDFORD INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of the law to the
 2 contrary, all administrative and professional personnel of the
 3 New Bedford Institute of Technology shall be upgraded from
 4 their present step-in-range in their respective job groups to
 5 the same step-in-range in the following job groups: —

7 Instructor	16
8 Assistant Professor	18
9 Associate Professor	21
10 Professor	23
11 President	31

12 An associate professor or professor approved for use at said
 13 state college in a position title designated with the prefix
 14 "Commonwealth" shall be in a job group two grades higher than
 15 the job group of associate professor or professor, respectively.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as to permanent em-
 2 ployees on July first, nineteen hundred and sixty-three, and as
 3 to professional personnel employed for each academic year,
 4 on September first, nineteen hundred and sixty-three.
