AN ACT AMENDING THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF MASSACHUSETTS  
FOR OTHER

It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Constitution of the State of Massachusetts is amended so that the Council shall have no power to report to the Senate on the subject of the proposed amendment.
