AN ACT RELATIVE TO FIRST AID TRAINING FOR AMBULANCE DRIVERS  
OR ATTENDANTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-  
2 ing out section 7F, inserted by chapter 136 of the acts of 1957,  
3 and inserting in place thereof the following section: — *Section*  
4 *7F*. No person shall operate any ambulance transporting a sick  
5 or injured person, nor shall the owner or custodian of an am-  
6 bulance permit the same to be so operated upon any way un-  
7 less the operator of such ambulance or an attendant thereon  
8 is at least eighteen years of age and has been certified as hav-  
9 ing successfully completed the standard or the advanced Red  
10 Cross course of first aid training, or has been certified by a  
11 registered physician or a licensed hospital as having completed  
12 instruction and training equivalent thereto.
