AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LICENSING OF AN INSURANCE AGENT,
BROKER, OR ADJUSTER OF FIRE LOSSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 175 of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appear-
2 ing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by insert-
3 ing after the word "license", in line 7, the following words:—
4 unless authorized by such firms and unless such authoriza-
5 tion shall be made known to the department of insurance.
