

By Mr. Kenneally, petition of George V. Kenneally, Jr., that provision be made to increase the salaries of the chief justice and associate justices of the municipal court of the city of Boston and the justices of certain district courts. The Judiciary.

AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF THE CHIEF JUSTICE AND ASSOCIATE JUSTICES OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON AND THE JUSTICES OF CERTAIN DISTRICT COURTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 75 of Chapter 218 of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by striking out said section, and inserting
3 in place thereof the following section: —

4 *Section 75.* The salary of the chief justice of the municipal
5 court of the city of Boston shall be nineteen thousand dollars
6 and the salary of each of the associate justices shall be eighteen
7 thousand dollars. Such justices shall devote their entire time
8 during ordinary business hours to their respective duties and
9 shall not, directly or indirectly, engage in the practice of law.

1 SECTION 2. Section 77A of chapter 218 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by chapter 379 of the acts of 1961,
3 is hereby amended by striking out the words “sixteen thousand
4 dollars” wherever they appear in said section and inserting in
5 place thereof the words: — eighteen thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any provision of this act to the
2 contrary, the provisions of sections seventy-five and seventy-
3 seven A of chapter two hundred and eighteen of the General
4 Laws in effect immediately prior to the effective date of this

5 act shall remain in effect and apply to appointments to the
6 offices referred to therein which are made on or after January
7 first, nineteen hundred and sixty-three.
