AN ACT TO ELIMINATE FORCE, VIOLENCE AND DESTRUCTION OF
PROPERTY IN LABOR DISPUTES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 9A of chapter 214 of the General Laws
2 as most recently amended by chapter 452 of the acts of 1950
3 is hereby further amended by deleting subdivision (4) of said
4 section 9A and by changing the designation of subdivisions
5 (5) and (6) thereof to subdivisions (4) and (5) respectively.

1 SECTION 2. Nothing contained in this act shall be deemed
2 to affect the discretionary powers which courts have tradi-
3 tionally exercised, without regard to the limitations of said
4 subdivision (4) which has been hereby repealed, in the grant-
5 ing or denying of equitable relief.
