**AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE FURTHER REGULATION OF THE LICENSING  
OF RUNNING HORSE RACING MEETINGS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 The State Racing Commission may issue to any licensee or  
2 licensees to whom it has issued in any year any license or  
3 licenses to conduct running horse racing meetings, not includ-  
4 ing running horse racing meetings at state and county fairs, a  
5 license or licenses to conduct an aggregate of forty-two racing  
6 days in any such year at all running horse racing meetings  
7 combined, not including running horse racing meetings at  
8 state and county fairs, said forty-two racing days to be in ad-  
9 dition to the aggregate of ninety racing days for which licenses  
10 may be issued as provided in clause (f) of subsection five of  
11 section three of chapter one hundred and twenty-eight A of  
12 the General Laws, any license or licenses issued under the  
13 provisions of this act shall, except as herein provided, be sub-  
14 ject to all provisions of said chapter one hundred and twenty-  
15 eight A, and the rules and regulations of said commission.  
16 Provided, however, that not more than sixty-six racing days  
17 may be granted or issued to any one licensee.
