The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Three.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING PERSONS OBSERVING SATURDAY AS THEIR SABBATH TO KEEP OPEN THEIR PLACES OF BUSINESS ON SUNDAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6 of chapter 136 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in chapter 616 of the acts of 1962, is hereby amended by strik-
3 ing out clause (8) and inserting in place thereof the following
4 clause: — (8) The conducting of any such activities on Sun-
5 day by or on behalf of any person who conscientiously believes
6 that the period between sundown Friday and sundown Satur-
7 day ought to be observed as the Sabbath, and actually refrains
8 from conducting such activities during that period; provided,
9 no nuisance is created thereby.
