AN ACT TO PROMOTE JOB GROWTH IN MASSACHUSETTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 136 of the General Laws as inserted by chapter 616
- 2 of the acts of 1962 is hereby amended by striking out section
- 3 13 and inserting in place thereof the following: —
- 4 *Section 13.* The provisions of sections five to eleven, inclu-
- 5 sive, shall, except as provided in section fourteen apply to all
- 6 legal holidays except February twenty-second, March seven-
- 7 teenth, April nineteenth, June seventeenth and with respect to
- 8 October twelfth between the hours of one post meridian and
- 9 twelve midnight. Whenever a legal holiday or a part thereof
- 10 to which sections five to eleven inclusive apply, occur on a
- 11 Sunday, it shall be observed on the following day.
