The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Three.

AN ACT REQUIRING TRADING STAMP COMPANIES TO REDEEM TRADING STAMPS OF OTHER SUCH COMPANIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 14M of chapter 93 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding at the end the following paragraph: —
- 3 No trading stamp company distributing or redeeming trad-
- 4 ing stamps in the commonwealth shall refuse to redeem trad-
- 5 ing stamps issued by any other such trading stamp company,
- 6 but shall redeem such stamps for the cash value thereof, as
- 7 printed upon their face, or in merchandise of a value equiv-
- 8 alent to that which the trading stamp company issuing such
- 9 stamps would have redeemed such stamps for.

AN ACT RESPECTING TRADE STAMPS ISSUED TO LICENSEE TRADING STAMPS OF OTHER PROVINCES.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

1. Section 144 of chapter 35 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding at the end the following paragraph:—
2. No trading stamp company, distributor or trading stamp agent in the province shall refuse to receive for the same any stamp issued by any other such trading stamp company, but shall receive such stamps for the cash value thereof, as printed upon their face, or in respect thereof a value equivalent to that which the trading stamp company issuing such stamps would have returned such stamps for.
