AN ACT DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN AN ARTIFICIAL ICE-SKATING RINK IN A CERTAIN AREA OF THE DORCHESTER DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized
- 2 and directed to construct and maintain an artificial ice-skating
- 3 rink on land of the Neponset river reservation between Granite
- 4 avenue bridge and Central avenue bridge in the Dorchester
- 5 district of the city of Boston. For said purpose said commis-
- 6 sion may expend such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
