AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO CONVEY THE WILLIAM H. GARVEY PLAYGROUND IN SAID CITY TO THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ICE-SKATING RINK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston is hereby authorized to
2 convey, without consideration, to the metropolitan district
3 commission a certain parcel of land in the Dorchester district
4 of said city known as the William H. Garvey Playground. Said
5 commission, on behalf of the commonwealth, shall accept from
6 said city a deed conveying said land and shall construct and
7 maintain thereon an artificial ice-skating rink in accordance
8 with the provisions of chapter seven hundred and sixty-eight
9 of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-two.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes of this act, said commission
2 shall, subject to appropriation, expend not more than four
3 hundred thousand dollars.
