AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY TO INSTALL OR CONSTRUCT ADEQUATE VENTILATION OR EXHAUST SYSTEM TO DISSIPATE EXHAUST FUMES IN THE HARVARD SQUARE SUBWAY, IN ORDER TO PERMIT THE UNDERGROUND USE OF SAID SUBWAY BY BUSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 That the Metropolitan Transit Authority be required to install or construct adequate ventilation or exhaust system to
- 2 dissipate exhaust fumes in the Harvard Square Subway, in
- 3 order to permit the underground use of said subway by buses.
