The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Three.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR EXTENSION OF RAPID TRANSIT FACILITIES IN THE CITY OF BOSTON AND TOWN OF MILTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 649 of the acts of 1949 is hereby  
 2 amended by inserting after section 3D, inserted by chapter  
 3 450 of the acts of 1957, the following section: — *Section 3E.*  
 4 The authority shall construct and equip an addition to the  
 5 existing Dorchester rapid transit extension in the city of Bos-  
 6 ton consisting of a rapid transit line crossing the Neponset  
 7 river and connecting with said Dorchester rapid transit exten-  
 8 sion at Ashmont station, in Boston, including thereon such sta-  
 9 tions, bridges, parking areas located adjacent to the Southeast  
 10 Expressway, and other appurtenant facilities as are deter-  
 11 mined by the authority to be necessary.

12 The authority may expend for the purposes of this section  
 13 not exceeding..... dollars. No construc-  
 14 tion work shall be done under this section until a preliminary  
 15 plan therefor, together with estimates of cost indicating that  
 16 the project can be completed at a cost not exceeding  
 17 ..... dollars, shall have been approved  
 18 by the commission of the department of public utilities. Any  
 19 plan so approved under this section may be altered at any  
 20 time by a new plan approved in like manner.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

## The Government of Massachusetts

It is the duty of the Governor to see that the laws are faithfully executed.

1. Section 1. Chapter 61B of the acts of 1962 is hereby amended by inserting after section 33B inserted by chapter 244A of the acts of 1961, the following section: — Section 33C. The authority shall maintain and equip an addition to the existing Thompsonville rapid transit extension in the city of Boston consisting of a rapid transit line extending the present 7 foot wide connecting with said Thompsonville rapid transit line at Johnson station in Boston including the station and 9 foot wide parking areas located adjacent to the station to Esplanade, and other appropriate facilities as are determined by the authority to be necessary.
2. The authority may proceed for the purpose of this section in the following manner: —
3. That work shall be done under the contract with a preliminary plan therefor, together with estimates of cost including all the project can be completed at a cost not exceeding \$10,000,000.
4. The authority may, in the discretion of the authority, may plan to proceed under this section may be altered at any time by a new plan approved in like manner.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
