AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE SUMMIT HOUSE  
LOCATED ON MOUNT SUGAR LOAF IN THE TOWN OF DEERFIELD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 The commissioners of the Mount Sugar Loaf Reservation are  
2 hereby authorized and directed to demolish and remove the  
3 structure known as the "Summit House," located on Mount  
4 Sugar Loaf in the town of Deerfield and to erect a new struc-  
5 ture in place thereof. For such purpose, the commissioners  
6 may expend therefor such funds as may be appropriated by  
7 the commonwealth.

**The Commission of Sanitation**

IN SENATE, JANUARY 22, 1895.

1. The Commission of Sanitation, created by Chapter 100 of the Laws of 1894, is authorized to make such rules and regulations as it may deem proper for the execution of the duties assigned to it by the said Chapter.

2. The Commission of Sanitation is authorized to employ such persons as it may deem proper, and to pay to them such salaries and wages as it may deem proper, and to purchase such supplies and materials as it may deem proper, for the execution of the duties assigned to it by the said Chapter.
