

By Mr. Graham, petition of Albert A. Gammal, Jr., and Gustaf Coontz for legislation relative to the disclosure on income tax returns of the full amount of earnings from gainful occupation of persons pensioned or retired for disability. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DISCLOSURE OF THE FULL AMOUNT OF EARNINGS FROM GAINFUL OCCUPATION ON INCOME TAX RETURNS OF PERSONS PENSIONED OR RETIRED FOR DISABILITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 91A of chapter 32 of the
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 303 of
3 the acts of 1961, is hereby further amended by adding at the
4 end the following sentence: — Every retiring authority or
5 officer shall on or before May first of each year submit to the
6 commissioner of corporations and taxation a list containing
7 the names and addresses of those persons pensioned or retired
8 by them under general or special law for disability including
9 accidental disability and said commissioner, notwithstanding
10 the provisions of section fifty-eight of chapter sixty-two, shall
11 within thirty days of the receipt of said list return said list to
12 the retiring board or officer with the full amount of earnings
13 from gainful occupation, if any, appearing on the income tax
14 returns of those persons whose names appear on said list.
