RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION OF THE LAWS OF THE COMMONWEALTH RELATIVE TO WATER POLLUTION.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid commission, to consist of one
2 member of the senate, two members of the house of represen-
3 tatives, the commissioner of public health or his designee, the
4 chairman of the water resources board or his designee, and
5 four persons to be appointed by the governor, all of whom
6 shall be representatives of either a national or state conserva-
7 tion organization is hereby established for the purpose of mak-
8 ing an investigation and study of the laws of the common-
9 wealth relative to water pollution.
