AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE QUALIFICATIONS OF INSPECTORS OF MEAT,  
SLAUGHTERING AND MILK.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 94 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after section 146 the following sec-  
3 tion: — *Section 146A.* No person shall be employed by the  
4 commonwealth or by any city or town as an inspector of meat  
5 or the slaughtering of animals or as an inspector of milk un-  
6 less such person is a registered veterinarian.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply only to inspectors employed  
2 after the effective date of this act.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE QUALIFICATION OF REGISTRARS OF DEEDS.

#### CHAPTER CXXVII.

It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Section 1. Chapter 94 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 140 the following:—  
 2. Sec. — Section 141. No person shall be eligible for appointment as Registrar of Deeds in any town or city unless he or she is a native-born citizen of the United States or the lawful and permanent resident of this Commonwealth.  
 3. No person is a qualified Registrar.

1. Section 2. This act shall apply only to Registrars appointed after the effective date of this act.
