AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH TO
CONSTRUCT A SWIMMING POOL AT THE PAUL A. DEVER STATE
SCHOOL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 The department of mental health is hereby authorized and
2 directed to construct a swimming pool at the Paul A. Dever
3 State School at Taunton for the use of the patients at said
4 school. Said department may expend for the construction of
5 said pool such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH TO
 CONSTRUCT A REFORMING SCHOOL AT THE TOWN OF DORSET STATE
 SCHOOL.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
 General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
 follows:

1. The department of mental health is hereby authorized and
 directed to construct a reformatory school at the town of Dorset.
 2. The school as provided for the use of the patients in said
 school. Said department may expend for the construction of
 said school such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
