RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ERECTION OF A STATUE OF CHRISTOPHER COLUMBUS.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of  
2 two members of the senate, three members of the house of  
3 representatives, and two persons to be appointed by the gov-  
4 ernor, is hereby established for the purpose of making an in-  
5 vestigation and study relative to the erection of a statue of  
6 Christopher Columbus.

By the Senate of the United States of America, in Executive Session, on the 15th day of March, 1907, the following resolution was passed:

The Government of the United States

Resolved, That the Secretary of the Interior be and he is authorized to
